
8.a. CONSIDERATION AND APPROVAL OF URGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 1264-U, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1263-U, EXTENDING THE CAR WASH USE AND EXPANSION MORATORIUM

Staff is requesting that the City Council adopt Urgency Ordinance No. 1264-U amending Urgency Ordinance No 1263-U extending the current 45-day moratorium for additional time of ten (10) months and fifteen (15) days per Government Code Section 65858, for a total of a one-year moratorium.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Staff recommends City Council:

1. Conduct a public hearing;
2. Take public testimony; and
3. Adopt Urgency Ordinance No. 1264-U amending Urgency Ordinance No. 1263-U, extending the 45-day moratorium by ten (10) months and fifteen (15) days prohibiting the establishment or expansion of car washes within City limits during the pendency of the City's review and adoption of permanent zoning regulations for such uses.
