

ORDINANCE NO. 1259

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SOUTH EL MONTE
REGARDING COMPENSATION OF COUNCILMEMBERS
AND AMENDING THE SOUTH EL MONTE MUNICIPAL
CODE

RECITALS

A. California Government Code Section 36516(a)(4) provides that cities may increase the salary of councilmembers five percent for each calendar year from the operative date of the last adjustment.

B. California Government Code Section 36516.5 allows for an increase in compensation for the entirety of the Council “whenever one or more members of the city council becomes eligible for a salary increase by virtue of the council member beginning a new term of office.” The new term of office for newly elected council members (after the November election) will begin on December 13, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE SOUTH EL MONTE CITY COUNCIL ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Council hereby deletes and replaces in its entirety Subsection B of Section 2.04.160 of Chapter 2.04 (City Council) of Title 2 (Administration and Personnel) of the South El Monte Municipal Code relating to councilmember salary to read as follows:

“B. Effective on or about December 13, 2022, the monthly salary for each member of the city council shall be one thousand-one-hundred thirty-three dollars and forty-three cents.”

Section 2. The change in salary shall become effective when one or more councilmembers commences a new term on or about December 13, 2022.


Section 3. The City Clerk shall attest and certify to the passage and adoption of the Ordinance.
