

Waiver and Release of VARA, CAPA, & Other Artists' Rights

In consideration for the City of South El Monte (the "City") selecting _____ (the "Artist") to create artwork described below (the "Artwork"), the Artist hereby represents and warrants that the Artist is the sole creator of the Artwork and has the full legal authority to enter into the following:

VARA/CAPA Release and Waiver

Artist hereby knowingly and voluntarily waives any and all rights the Artist may have with respect to the Artwork under the federal Visual Artists Rights Act of 1990 ("VARA") (17 U.S.C. sections 106A and 113(d)), the California Art Preservation Act ("CAPA") (Cal. Civil Code sections 987 et seq.), and any other local, state, federal or international laws that convey rights of the same nature as those conveyed under VARA and CAPA. This waiver applies to all rights of attribution and integrity, including, but not limited to, the right to prevent any alteration, modification, distortion, mutilation, destruction, or removal of the Artwork, including destruction of a work of recognized stature. The Artist agrees that the City, and its officers, officials, employees, agents, successors, and assigns, shall have the sole discretion to change, modify, destroy, remove, move, replace, transport, repair, restore, or otherwise dispose of the Artwork at any time and without notice of any kind to the Artist.
